A list of compulsory samples and six practical artefacts four of which should include art forms with one of the art forms being a wearable item.

An option form as one item must be mixed media, the second medium is of your choice.

Collage/Wall Hanging/Textile pictures

Designing/commissions

Mixed media

Marriage of yarn, stitches, and colour

Crochet Sculpture

Art and free forms in crochet

Studying for the research project and its final presentation

Taking the examination by distance

Notes on being questioned orally on the written research project and question paper

Record sheet of your assessments.

(Note: there is a Scheme B available for those wishing to continue only with the practical aspects of crochet – and not submit a research project or notes on how the various crochet pieces came into being).

2. Four BI-MONTHLY NEWSLETTERS once you have enrolled, with the option to continue taking them should you not have completed Part II before they end

3. A CERTIFICATE showing that you have succeeded in obtaining the necessary high standard in all areas is issued showing you have completed Part Three of the International Diploma in Crochet – “Mixed-Media”. If you have chosen to successfully complete Scheme B, a letter of achievement to that effect will be issued

4. Should you also have completed Parts I & II of the International in Diploma in Crochet, you will be presented with a full diploma showing you are a Graduate of the International in Diploma in Crochet
